WHAT AN EXTRAORDINARY MOMENT THIS IS

Thank you for answering the call and for your faithful commitment to prayer and intercession on behalf of our communities, our leaders, and our country.

Our focus has been on praying for the sphere of government, which includes Parliament, the 123 elected representatives, the six political parties currently in office, government officials, and the various governmental departments. We have lifted up legislation and policy not only the process within Parliament, but also their practical outworking in our communities.

Whilst our primary focus has been on Parliament in Wellington, we fully recognise the broader reach of governmental authority throughout our land. This authority is exercised across the 65 General Electorates and the 7 Māori Electorates—72 electoral boundaries in total that carry governmental significance across Aotearoa.

72/72 is a call to dedicate one hour of prayer for each electorate over the course of three consecutive days. We stand together, united in purpose and intent under the will of our Living God, as we intercede for our leaders, our people, and the land of Aotearoa, New Zealand.

PREPARING FOR YOUR HOUR

- > Read your electorate profile and know the boundary lines you are praying in.
- You may like to use our online <u>Prayer Walking Resource</u> and get out on the streets ahead of your hour of prayer.
- Print out your electorate map and highlight all the key buildings and places in your electorate
- Highlight any significant places where significant events have taken place, e.g. historical events of injustice. You may like to do further research in your area to understand what's happened.
- > Have the name and a photo of your MP who represents your electorate in parliament.
- > Have a list of the other MP's who live in your area. e.g. List MP's
- You may like to fast in the lead-up to 72/72
- > Ask your friends if they would like to join you in praying for your MP and electorate.



HOW TO PRAY FOR YOUR ELECTORATE



Praying for your MP

Your MP has been elected to serve your community, representing more than just party politics—they carry your local concerns and hopes. Pray for chances to connect with them, invite them to community events, and engage in conversation to better understand their views, motivations, and how they plan to represent your area. Pray for their well-being and that of their families—remember, they are loved by God too. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide their conscience, especially on morally significant issues, that they may recognise the lasting impact of their decisions.



Research

Research and seek information to have knowledge and insight into your electorate boundaries, the demographics of the people, and its history, past and present. Get to know the key players because they are often the gatekeepers, the movers and shakers, and will have significant influence. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal the hidden things (there are always new things to discover even if you know your community well).



Awareness

Ask the Holy Spirit to keep you vigilant. Raise awareness of political initiatives, laws and policies that seek to destroy the peace and prosperity of your community. Many initiatives aim to break down the family unit by subtly disguising themselves as shared values, e.g. freedom of choice.

HOW TO PRAY FOR YOUR ELECTORATE



Wisdom and Insight

Call on the power of the Holy Spirit to give you wisdom, insight and understanding as you seek advice for particular areas that you and other intercessors feel burdened to pray into. Pray for the appropriate Spirit-filled Christian who understands the issues well and has an authority to act in these particular areas (e.g. significant historical event of injustice and unrighteousness that has left unrest and unresolved trauma and wounds upon the land and the amongst the people).



Strength

Pray for Christians who are burdened with the calling to intercede for the political leaders in New Zealand that they will not grow weary, be discouraged, or wane from their calling to stand in the gap.



Protection

Pray for the protection of the intercessors and their families, marriages, relationships, business, ministries, finance, health and properties from any evil intentions and attacks.



Boldness

Pray for the Christians within your electorate community committed to interceding and actively presenting the gospel in simple ways to everyday people. (There are many examples where the love of God is demonstrated that have earned the respect and love of the local people.)
